## DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY BY THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF MARVIN, NORTH CAROLINA

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 166A-19.22 of the North Carolina General Statutes and in accordance with Chapter 32 of the Village of Marvin Ordinances, the Mayor of the Village Council is authorized and empowered to declare that a state of emergency exists within the Village of Marvin; and

**WHEREAS**, Hurricane Florence threatens to cause significant damage to the Village of Marvin to include isolated tornadoes, significant flooding, powerful hurricane force winds, downed trees, downed powerlines, significant power outages, and substantial property damage.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority vested in me as the Mayor of the Village of Marvin under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Chapter 32 of the Village of Marvin Code of Ordinances:

**Section 1.** A State of Emergency is hereby declared within the jurisdiction of the Village of Marvin.

**Section 2.** The emergency area covered by this state of emergency shall be the entire Village of Marvin.

**Section 3.** The following restrictions and prohibitions are imposed:

- A. The Village Administrator/designee, is authorized to make emergency purchases and contracts as necessary to deal with this incident.
- B. Citizens are encouraged to stay home and off primary and secondary roads if reasonably possible and to limit necessary travel to daylight hours so as not to interfere with efforts of emergency and repair crews. Citizens are encouraged to conserve fuel, food, water, etc.

**Section 4.** I hereby order all Village of Marvin/Union County law enforcement officers and employees and all other emergency management personnel subject to our control to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of the provisions of this Declaration, all applicable local ordinances, state and federal laws, and the Village of Marvin/Union County Emergency Operations Plan.

**Section 5.** I hereby order this declaration: (a) to be distributed to the news media and other organizations calculated to bring its contents to the attention of the general public; (b) to be filed with Clerk to the Village Council and (c) to be posted on the Village Bulletin Board and otherwise distributed to others as necessary to ensure proper implementation of this declaration.

**Section 6.** This declaration shall take effect on Thursday, September 13, 2018 at 8:00 p.m. and shall remain in effect until rescinded or automatically expires within five (5) days.


