**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF MARVIN, NORTH CAROLINA**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 90 APPENDING A SECTION TO REQUIRE THAT DOGS BE RESTRAINED OR ENCLOSED WHEN OUTSIDE IN THE VILLAGE OF MARVIN, NORTH CAROLINA

**WHEREAS**, The Village of Marvin desires to improve the safety of its' residents from owned dogs; and

**WHEREAS**, The Village of Marvin seeks to require that dogs be restrained or enclosed when outside.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Village Council for the Village of Marvin, North Carolina that:


Section 1. Title IX: GENERAL REGULATIONS, §90.087 entitled "Physical Restraint", shall be appended to Chapter 90 entitled "Animal Control" of the Code of Ordinance of the Village of Marvin, North Carolina as follows:


**§ 90.087 PHYSICAL RESTRAINT – OFF PREMISES.**

It shall be unlawful for any person owning or having possession, charge, custody or control of any dog, to allow such dog off the premises, unless such dog is under sufficient physical restraint which controls the dog. If the physical restraint used is a leash requiring a person to control the dog, the person using such restraint must be of sufficient age and physical size or ability to reasonably restrain the dog.

This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption and ordered published as provided by law.
